

Selecting Students

When you run reports to analyze student test scores, Edusoft lets you select a set of students based on factors such as roster, grade, ethnicity, and other demographics. Depending on your district, you may be able to choose students based on tracks or school groups.

When you're selecting a set of students, your result is determined by:

- The roster you choose

Edusoft imports roster information from your Student Information System (SIS) and from state test rosters (if available). You can select different rosters depending on the type of data you're looking at.

- The demographic options you choose

Depending on your roster, you can select demographic factors such as ethnicity, gender, educational program, grade, course, or custom group. You use these factors to narrow down your set of students.

To select a roster:

- 1 Click the **Roster** link in the Select Students Based On area.

The links you see here depend on your district and whether you're a teacher or an administrator.

The number of students who match your current demographic selections appears in parentheses. This number changes depending on what you've selected so far. Here's an example:



With no other demographic options selected, the number of female students who took the test is 309.

Next, click the **Course** link. The number of *female* students, enrolled in *6th Grammar*, who took the test is 92.

Next, click the **Teachers** link. The number of students who took the test who are *female*, enrolled in *6th Grammar*, and who have *Tim A.* as a teacher is 12.
